The Experience of Online Health Information Use among Stroke Caregivers: An Interpretive Description Study

Location: Ontario only.

Description: This study aims to investigate the experience of using online health information among stroke caregivers. This study aims to gain a comprehensive understanding of caregivers' experiences with online health information. Recruitment will occur virtually (province of Ontario) through online support groups and through social media.

Language: English only.

Eligibility:

- 18 years or older
- actively involved in caregiving (min. 3 months) for an individual who has had a stroke
- proficient in English.

Participant requirements: Data will be collected through audio-recorded telephone or zoom interviews with stroke caregivers lasting approximately 30-45 minutes. Interviews will be scheduled at the participants convenience. Interview questions will be semi-structured and open-ended responses to allow participants to discuss their personal experiences using online health information in a natural free-flowing way. Questions in the interview will focus on understanding the experience of online health information use among participants. Involvement ends when interview is complete.

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
